- o The submission file is in Microsoft Word file format.
- o Where available, DOIs for the references have been provided.
- o The text is single-spaced; uses Times New Roman 12-point font; employs italics, rather than underlining (except with URL addresses); and all illustrations, figures, and tables are placed within the text at the appropriate points, rather than at the end.
- o The text adheres to the stylistic and bibliographic requirements outlined in the Author Guidelines.

## **Author Guidelines**

Research Management Cell (RMC), Chaturbhujeshwar Janata Multiple Campus, Harion, Sarlahi invites articles in prescribed format for its peer-reviewed journal viz. *Chaturbhujeshwar Academic Journal* from scholars, researchers, teachers and others having a keen interest in research professionalism. Submitted articles will be reviewed by the renowned experts following the double-blind peer review process and contributors will be notified for further modifications if needed.

## **Article format**

The manuscript should include an abstract of about 150–250 words along with up to seven keywords, and its overall length must fall between 6 and 12 pages, totaling roughly 4,000 to 6,000 words. The document should be prepared in a single column on A4 paper in portrait orientation, using a 1.5-inch margin on the left and 1-inch margins on the other sides. Use single line spacing, with each paragraph starting after a 6-point space and ending with no extra spacing. Keep the header and footer within a 1 cm margin. Headings and subheadings should not be numbered, and all references must follow APA 7th edition style. Footnotes are not allowed. If you include any acknowledgements or declarations, place them just before the references, and keep any appendices short, placing them after the reference list. Finally, submit the manuscript in both Word and PDF formats.

Authors will be responsible for plagiarism checking. Plagiarized writing from any author might result in the cancelling of that particular author from submitting articles to this journal later on as well.
