SURVEY ON THE AVIAN DIVERSITY ALONG THE ANNAPURNA SANCTUARY TREKKING ROUTE IN WESTERN NEPAL

ABSTRACT

A bird survey was carried out on one of Nepal's most popular trekking destinations, Annapurna Base Camp in the Annapurna Conservation Area (ACA). ACA trekking route was selected as our transect line. Direct observation method and call count method were used during the survey following the transect line. A total of 166 species were recorded representing nine orders and 39 families. The main objective of the present work was to study the avian diversity. Eight nationally threatened and three globally threatened bird species were recorded during the survey. White-rumped vulture *Gyps bengalensis* (Gmelin) and Red-headed vulture *Sarcogyps calvus* (Scopoli) (critically endangered species) were also recorded. The abundancy of Rufous sibia *Malacias capistratus* (Vigors) was higher, while Nepal house martin *Delichon nipalense* (Moore) had the highest number. Hunting, excessive harvesting of bamboo shoots, orchids, overgrazing and improper management of solid waste were directly observed threats.

INTRODUCTION

Among 887 bird species in Nepal, 518 species have been recorded in Annapuma Conservation Area including significant population of Cheer Pheasant *Catreus wallichii* (Hardwicke), a globally threatened species (Baral, 2018). Mammals total 104 species including some of the world's rare and endangered species such as, the Snow Leopard, *Panthera uncia uncia* (Schreber); Red Panda, *Aihurus fulgens* (Cuvier); Himalayan Musk Deer, *Moschus chrysogaster*

(Hodgson) and others like the Asiatic Wild Dog, Cuon alpines (Pallas); Himalayan Black Bear, Ursus thibetanus (Cuvier); Smooth-coated Otter, Lutrogale perspicillata (Hilaire); Clouded Leopard, Neofelis nebulosa (Griffith). etc. (NTNC, 2015). In addition, 39 reptile species and 22 amphibian species have been found (NTNC, 2015). The high number (1,226 species) of flowering plants has also been recorded (NTNC, 2015).

The conservation area is the country's only protected area that supports all of Nepal's six Himalayan pheasant species including the splendid Himalayan Monal, Lophophorus impejanus (Latham), the country's national bird, known as Danphe in Nepal. It is found on steep grassy slopes and open rocky slopes above the treeline upto 4,570 m in summer, descending to lower altitudes down to 3,300 m in rhododendron forest during winter. The Globally threatened Cheer Pheasant Catreus wallichii (Hardwicke) is significant in the precipitous terrain with scrub, tall grasses and stunted trees, steep hillsides of Ghasa, Pipar and Santel (Inskipp, 2017).

The main objective of the present investigation was to study the avian diversity along the Annapurna Sanctuary trekking route.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

Study area




Figure 1. Location map of study area.

Annapurna Conservation Area (Figure.1) is located at 28°32'N and 84°00'E in western Nepal around the Annapurna massifs. It includes one of the most impressive mountain range in the world, popularly known as the Annapurna Sanctuary which is surrounded by high peaks over 7,000 meters.

The study area comprises the Annapurna Sanctuary trekking trail (Nayapool- Ghandruk-

Chomroong-Sinuwa-Bamboo-Dovan-Himalaya-Deurali-Machhapuchre Base Camp- Annapurna Base Camp- Sinuwa-Jhinu-Landruk-Pokhara). The altitude ranges from 700 m to 4.130m.

Data Collection

Direct observation method

The trekking route was taken as the transect line and the survey was conducted along the transect line by direct count method and call count method and all birds encountered were recorded. The survey was opportunistic. Trekking guide map was also used during the trip collected from ACAP office.

Four binoculars Bushnell and Nikon 8x42, and digital cameras, Nikon D3100 (70-300), D5100 (18-55), Nikon Coolpix p900 (2000mm) optics were used in the field. In addition, Garmin GPSmap62S GPS and field guides, *Birds of Nepal* (Grimmett *et al.* 2003), *Birds of the Indian Subcontinent* by Grimmett *et al.* (2011), and Grimmett *et al.* (2016) and Inskipp *et al.* (2016) were followed for identification.

Call count method

Calls of some of the species were also recorded and identified during the survey. Xento-canto source was used as key identification tool.

We followed Call Count Method for nocturnal birds. Tape recorder with environment friendly volume was used to play the calls of nocturnal birds. Each call was played for 10 seconds and paused for next 50 seconds. Till this time we waited for response call. Their call back record was kept as bird species available in those areas. This method was continued for 5 times. Similar method and used for other different species of birds. The calls were downloaded from Xentocanto source was used as key identification tool (https://www.xeno-canto.org/).

Analysis and mapping

Simple statistical methods were used with the help of SPSS software to analyze the recorded data which refers to the number of species recorded during the survey (direct observation method and call count method). GPS was used to record the walking trail and GPS points. GPS coordinates were used for making GIS Map.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

We recorded 166 species of birds in the study area representing 5 orders and 39 families. Bird rich families were Timaliidae (27 species), Turdidae (19 species), Sylviidae (10 species) and Muscicapidae (6 species). Among recorded species, *Rufous sibia* was sighted more frequently, showing that it is the most widely distributed species on the Annapurna Base Camp (ABC) trek, however its population appeared to be much less than some other species including Nepal House Martin. Similarly, the forests between Ghandruk, Chhomrong, Sinuwa, Jhinu and Bamboo were found to have the highest species richness.

Birds recorded from their calls were, Black Francolin, Francolinus francolinus (two calls between Sauibazar and Kimche); Hill Partridge, Arborophila torqueloa (seventeen calls between Ghandruk and Khimrong Dada); Rufous throated Partridge, Arborophila rufogularis (one call at Khomrong Dada); Mountain Scops Owl, Otus spilocephalus (more than 100 calls at Ghandruk); Golden-throated Barbet, Megalaima franklinii (one call recorded at Ghandruk); Nepal Wren Babbler, Pnoepyga immaculate (two calls between Komrong Danda to Komrong Khola) and Pygmy Wren Babbler, Pnoepyga pusilla (one call at Ghandruk).

Threats like rock mining taking out rocks, boulders and sand for use in constructing new houses and lodges, a new motor road construction going on rapidly, children carrying catapults, uncontrolled livestock grazing, harvesting bamboo shoots and orchids were observed from Chhomrong and above, all the way to Deurali. Lack of solid waste management – unmanaged rubbish pits were observed along the trail. In addition the trekking route seemed to be very busy, helicopter and overgrazing were found to be the main disturbing factors to bird community.

Present study recommends to raise conservation awareness about the importance of birds to both residents and visitors within the conservation area and to improve the trekking trail and provide suspension bridges along the trekking route between Himalaya and Deurali in the Modi Khola valley which will help to promote bird ecotourism on the ABC trek in the conservation area.
